Computer Fire Modeling: Mathematical computer fire modeling is the "State-of-the-Art" in fire investigation technology. It requires careful judgment to accurately utilize information gained from the models. The course will introduce the student to Fire Dynamics Tools (FDTs), CFAST, and Fire Dynamics Simulator/Smokeview (FDS). Additionally, the student will be given valuable information regarding the history of computer fire models, input required to successfully implement computer models, how to interpret the output data, to test their hypotheses, and to provide hands-on examples of how they can be used by fire investigators in the field. The instructors will outline the strengths and limitations of the models and provide a solid basis for further study.

Certified Fire Investigator Instructor (CFII): This course centers around instructor methodology as it relates to the field of fire investigation. Topics: Theories of Adult Learning, Evaluation Practice, Instructional Techniques, Objectives, Session and Course Content, and Safety & Standards. The certification examination will be held at the end of this one-day training program. Though the CFEI designation is required to become a National Board Certified Fire Investigation Instructor, individuals who wish to get both certificates will be allowed to take the instructors program first. Upon successful completion of both examinations, both certifications will be issued.
